These materials have been made for pupils who may be working on text level work in class which is far in advance of their word and sentence level work. So although the text level may be from KS2 there is still chance to develop some of the foundation work from KS1

When you download the files you can save the file to your hard drive or to a floppy disc. You can use this file to install the resources to any machine that has Writing with Symbols 2000.

All the files will be found inside your WWS2000Work directory. The Books and information sheet are PDF files and will be a folder called Activities PDF. The worksheets will be in the Writing directory, in a folder called Activities, and the WWS Environments will be found in your Wizard Environments folder, also inside Activities. There are environments in each of the NT-2000, Hi-re and Lo-res folders

The packs all use a wordlist called **widgit packs.wus** which will be installed into the wordlists folder. Some activities also have new graphics. These will be installed into your MyPics1 folder in a directory called **Widgit Work Packs**.

You will need to use this wordlist if you want to make any extra resources of your own. This is based on the wordlists **Widgit A**, but you can also merge this wordlist with your own preferred list to get all the symbols you may want.

Goldilocks big story (PDF)	PDF file to print	2. Print paper book A4 . Make a book to use as reference for the activities.
Goldilocks short story (PDF)	PDF file to print	3. Print paper book and cut to make a small A5 book. Cut off the bottom part of each page with key words on
Goldilocks big story	WWS file to read on screen	4. Read story on screen and print paper book A4 .
Goldilocks short story	WWS file to read on screen	5. Read the story on screen with speech support.

Activities based on the story

Goldilocks sentence halves	WWS Grid to print	6. Cut out the sentence parts and stick together in workbook.
GOL-Halves	WWS Environment	7. Put the sentences together on screen.
Goldilocks- describing grid	WWS grid to print	8. Join the sentence halves
GOL- describe	WWS Environment to do on screen	9. Complete the sentence to give the appropriate description of what Goldilocks found
GOL-Here is	WWS Environment to do on screen	10. Computer activity to build simple sentences
Goldilocks Yes or No	WWS document to print	11. Questions about the story with answers to stick in place.
GOL-True False	WWS Environment to do on screen	12. Click on a sentence and then on a cell to say if it is true or false.
Adjectives highlighted	WWS document to print	13. Adjectives are highlighted in red. Use for discussion
Adjectives from Goldilocks	WWS document to print	14. Task for student to colour the adjectives on paper.
Goldilocks 15 key words.	WWS grid to print	15. Grid to sequence the story. Print out as word mat and use to support those more able to write.
