Worksheets and activities to support the traditional story red Riding Hood from Shirley Austin.

These materials have been made for pupils who may be working on text level work in class which is far in advance of their word and sentence level work. So although the text level may be from KS2 there is still chance to develop some of the foundation work from KS1

These is also a version of the story that can be read on-line at www.symbolworld.org

When you download the files you can save the file to your hard drive or to a floppy disc. You can use this file to install the resources to any machine that has Writing with Symbols 2000.

All the files will be found inside your WWS2000Work directory. The Books and information sheet are PDF files and will be a folder called Activities PDF. The worksheets will be in the Writing directory, in a folder called Activities, and the WWS Environments will be found in your Wizard Environments folder, also inside Activities. There are environments in each of the NT-2000, Hi-re and Lo-res folders.

The packs all use a wordlist called **widgit packs.wus** which will be installed into the wordlists folder. Some activities also have new graphics. These will be installed into your MyPics1 folder in a directory called **Widgit Work Packs**.

You will need to use this wordlist if you want to make any extra resources of your own. This is based on the wordlists **Widgit A**, but you can also merge this wordlist with your own preferred list to get all the symbols you may want.
