




John Lennon was born in Liverpool in 1940.

John grew up in Liverpool with his Aunt Mimi.




John grew up reading lots of short stories.

George Harrison joined the band aged 14.




John and Paul began writing their own songs.

They played in Hamburg in Germany for 2 years.




In 1960 they changed the name to the Beatles.

The Beatles became the best selling band ever.




In 1969 John married Yoko Ono.

This type of protest is called non-violent.




Musically the Beatles began to grow apart.

John believed in social justice and world peace.




In 1970 the Beatles broke up.

John recorded many songs with Yoko.




Imagine is John's most famous solo album.

John's music is still played everywhere.


John won awards for his music with the Beatles.
