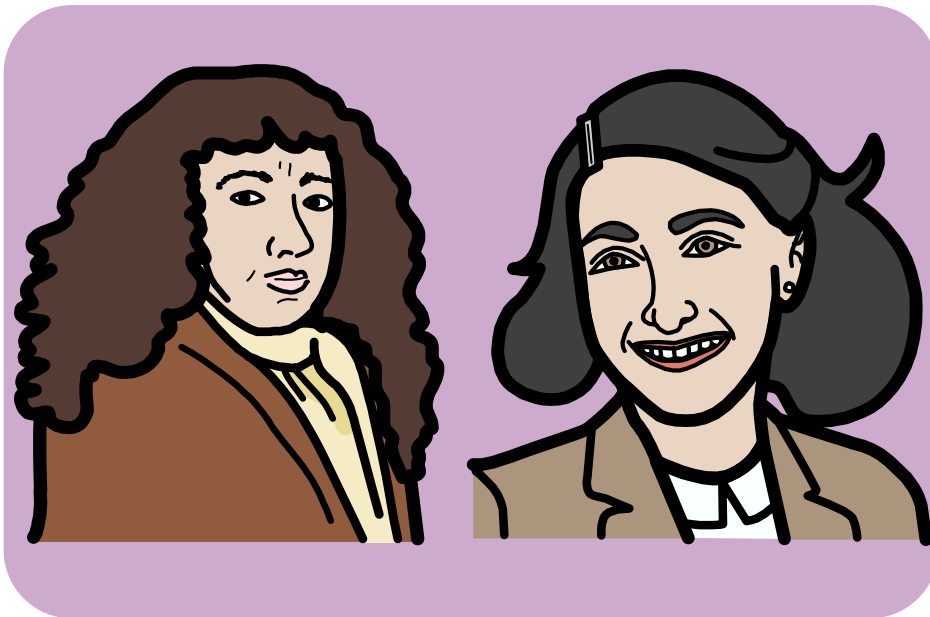

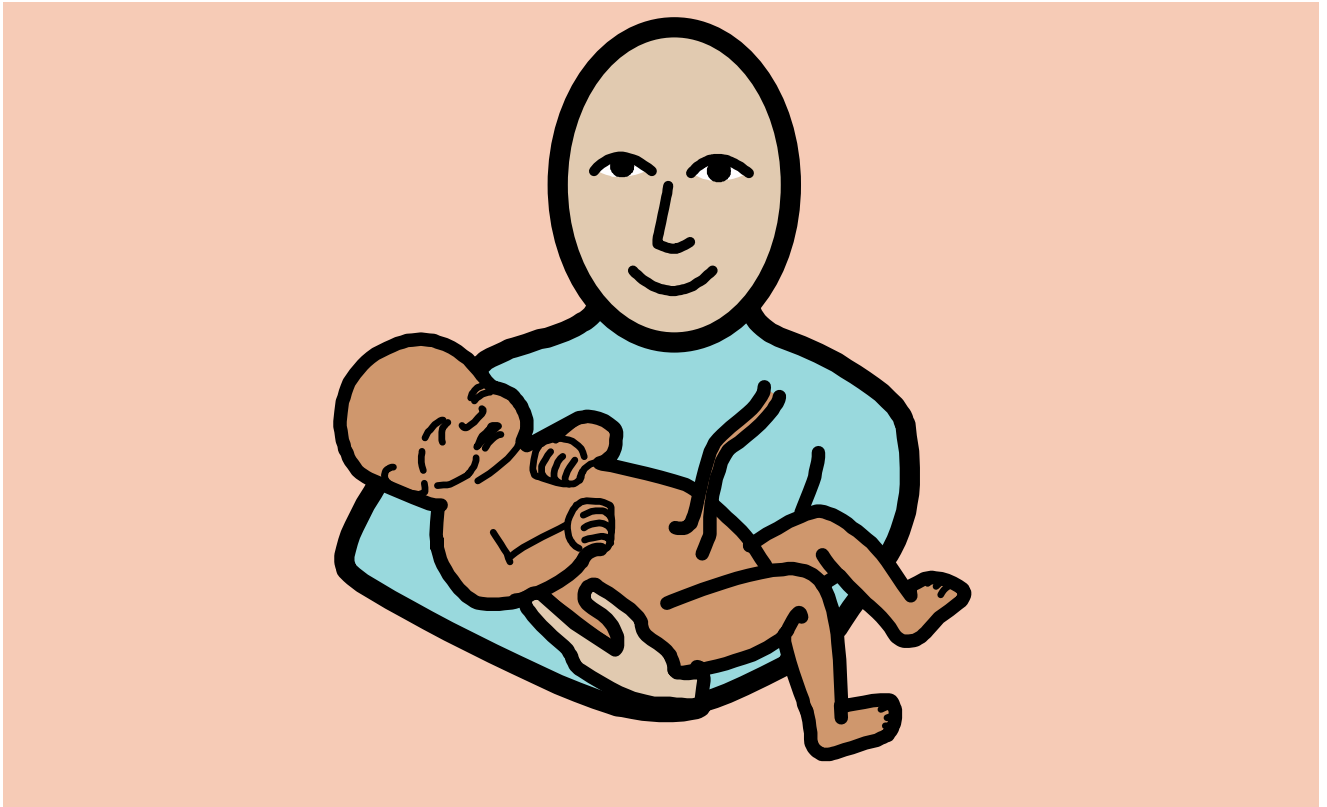

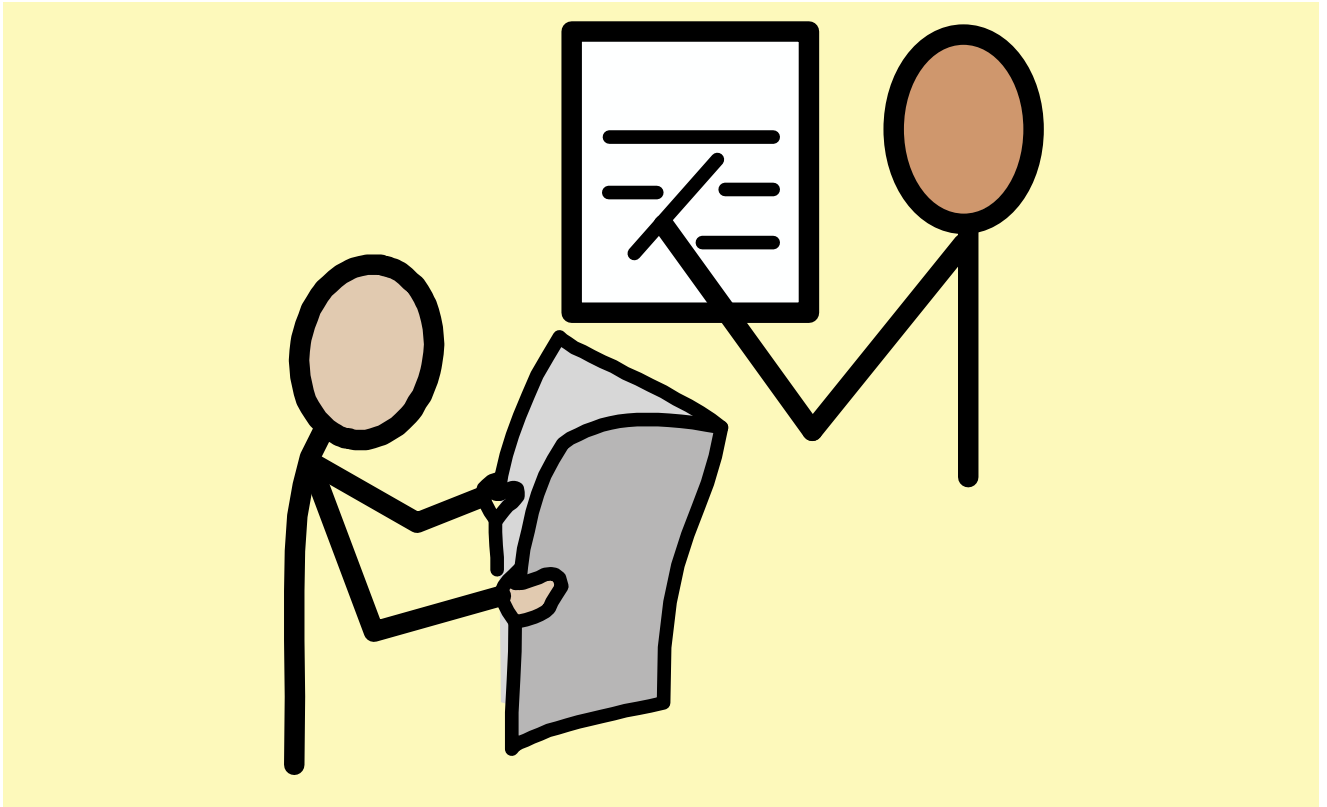


Anne Frank was born in Germany, in 1929.

He was baptised as a Christian in church.

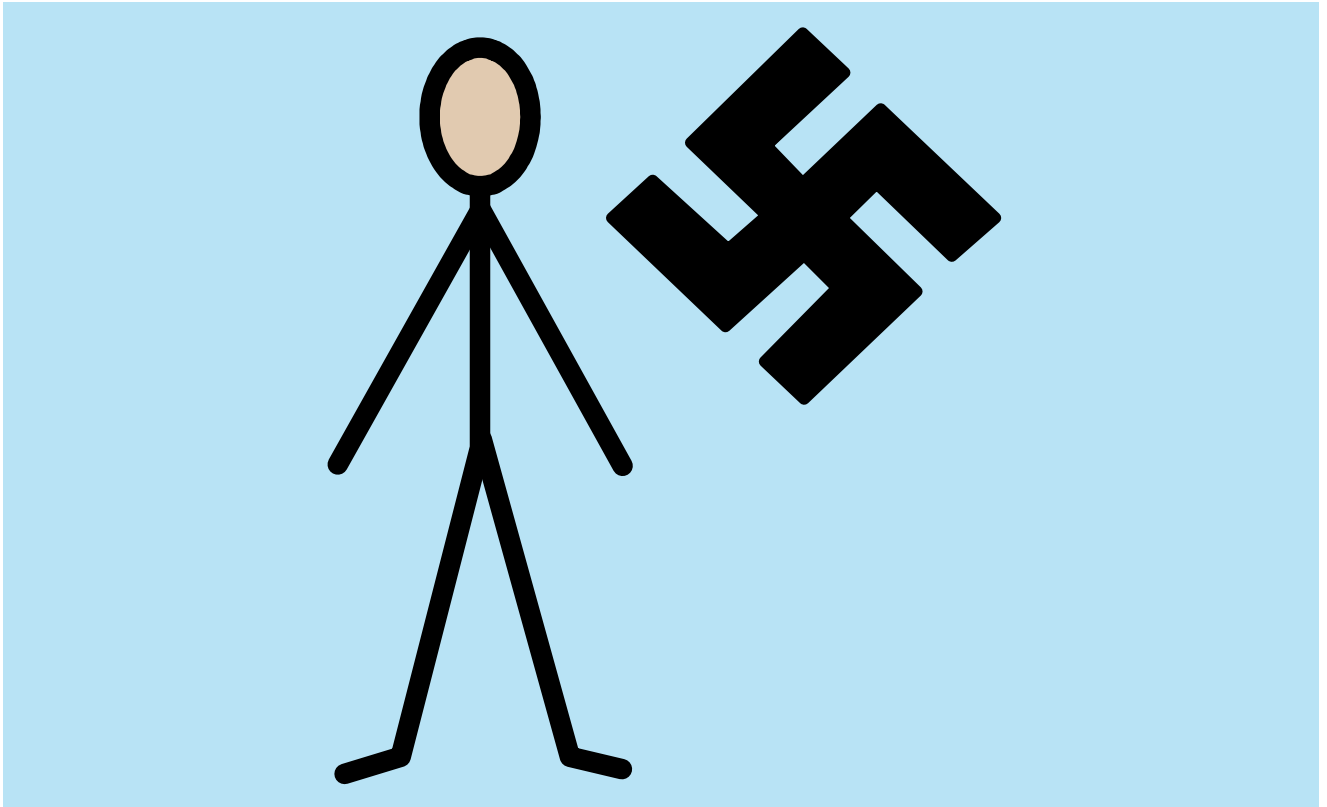


Anne enjoyed reading and writing at school.

She wrote all about life in hiding with her family.

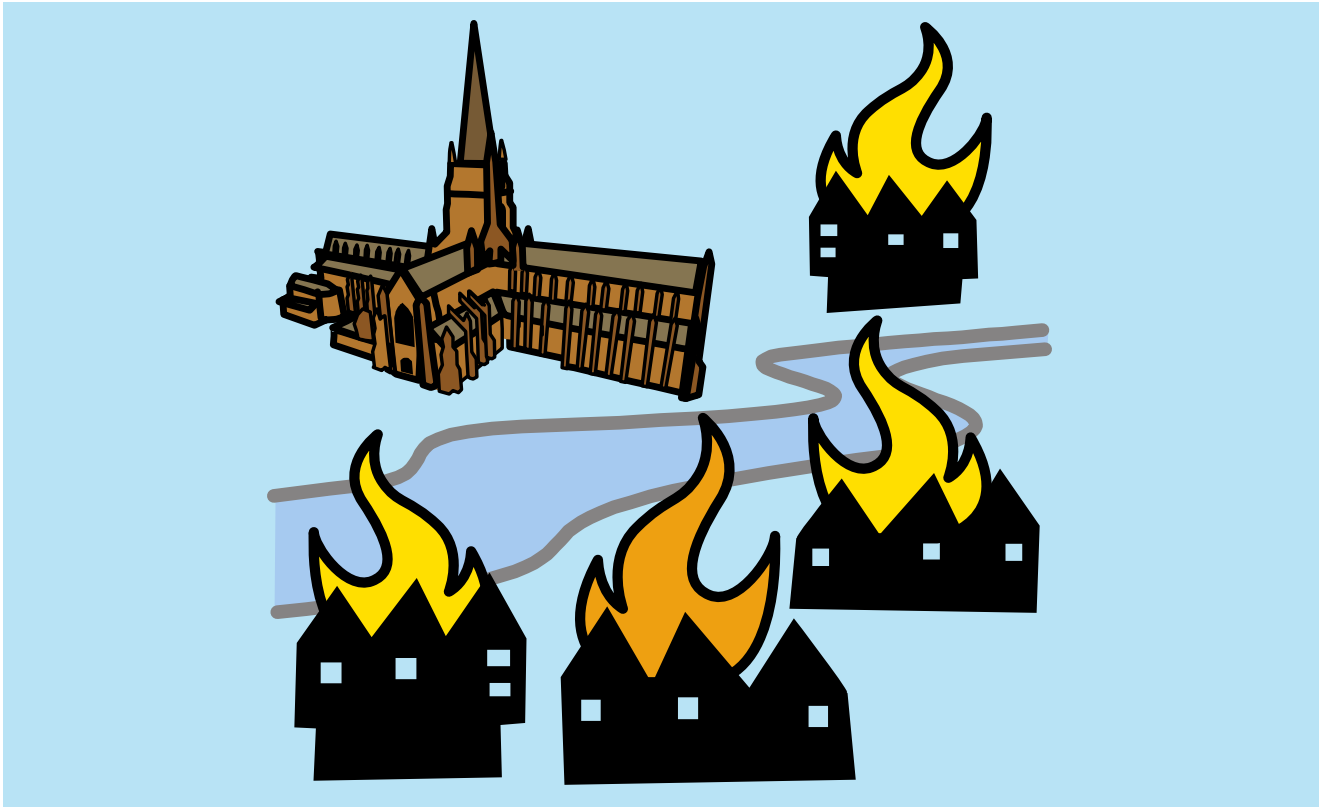


From 1660 until 1669 Pepys also kept a diary.

He liked wine, plays and socialising with others.

He also commented on important national events.

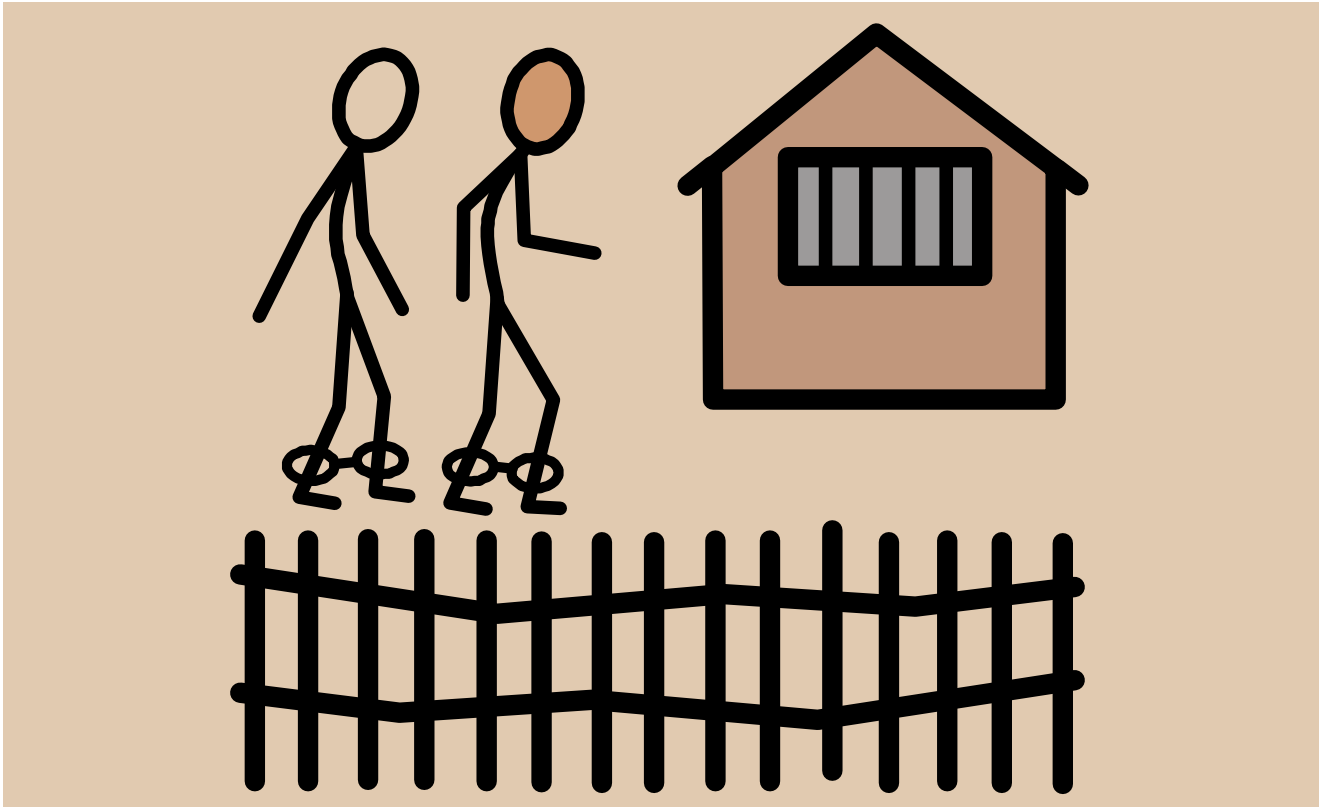


Pepys described the Great Plague of 1665 - 1666.

He also wrote about the Great Fire of London of 1666.

Anne's diary ended after she was captured by Nazi's.

In Auschwitz she was worked as a slave.

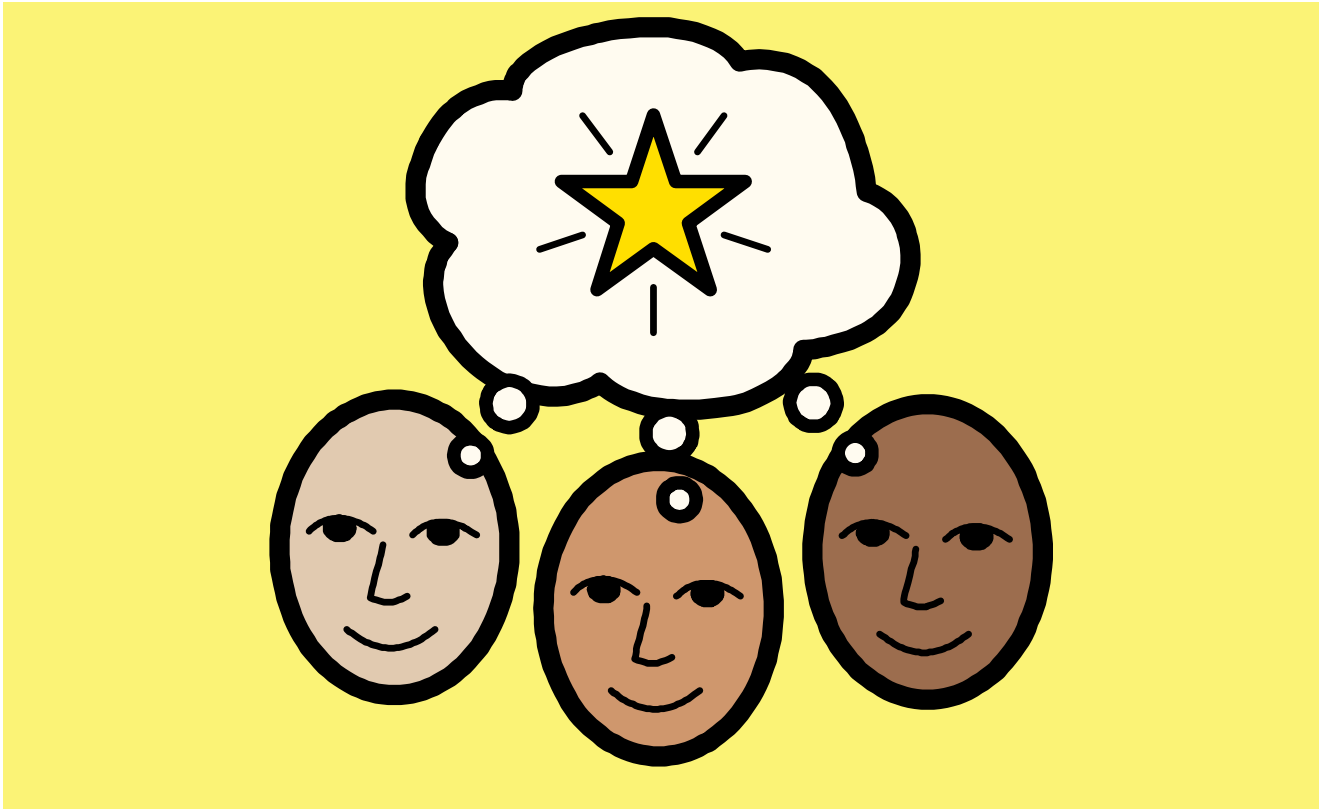


Pepys had a senior role in the navy and was an MP.

He also became a fellow of the Royal Society.

Anne was later sent to Belson aged 15.

Infectious diseases killed thousands of prisoners.

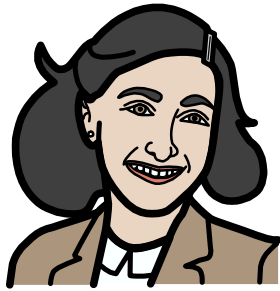


Pepys moved to Clapham, where he died in 1703.

He has been called the greatest diarist of all time.

Anne had died by 1945, buried in a mass grave.

Published in 1947, Anne's diary is also world famous.



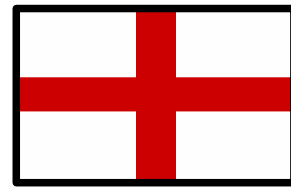
