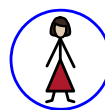
Pepys wrote about the people he didn't like.



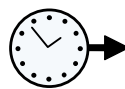
He also didn't like London as it was too crowded.

 Later she liked her mother and sister more.







At 1st Pepys wrote his diary for himself.







But he re-wrote it and bound it in 6 volumes.






At 1st Anne wrote her diary for herself.
