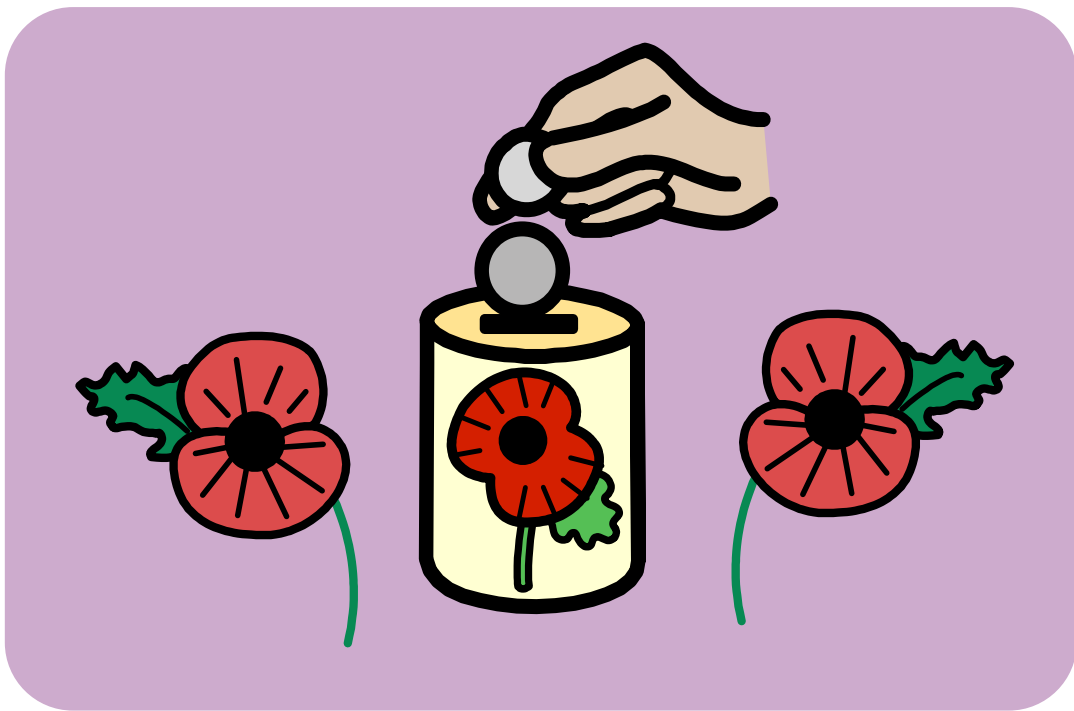

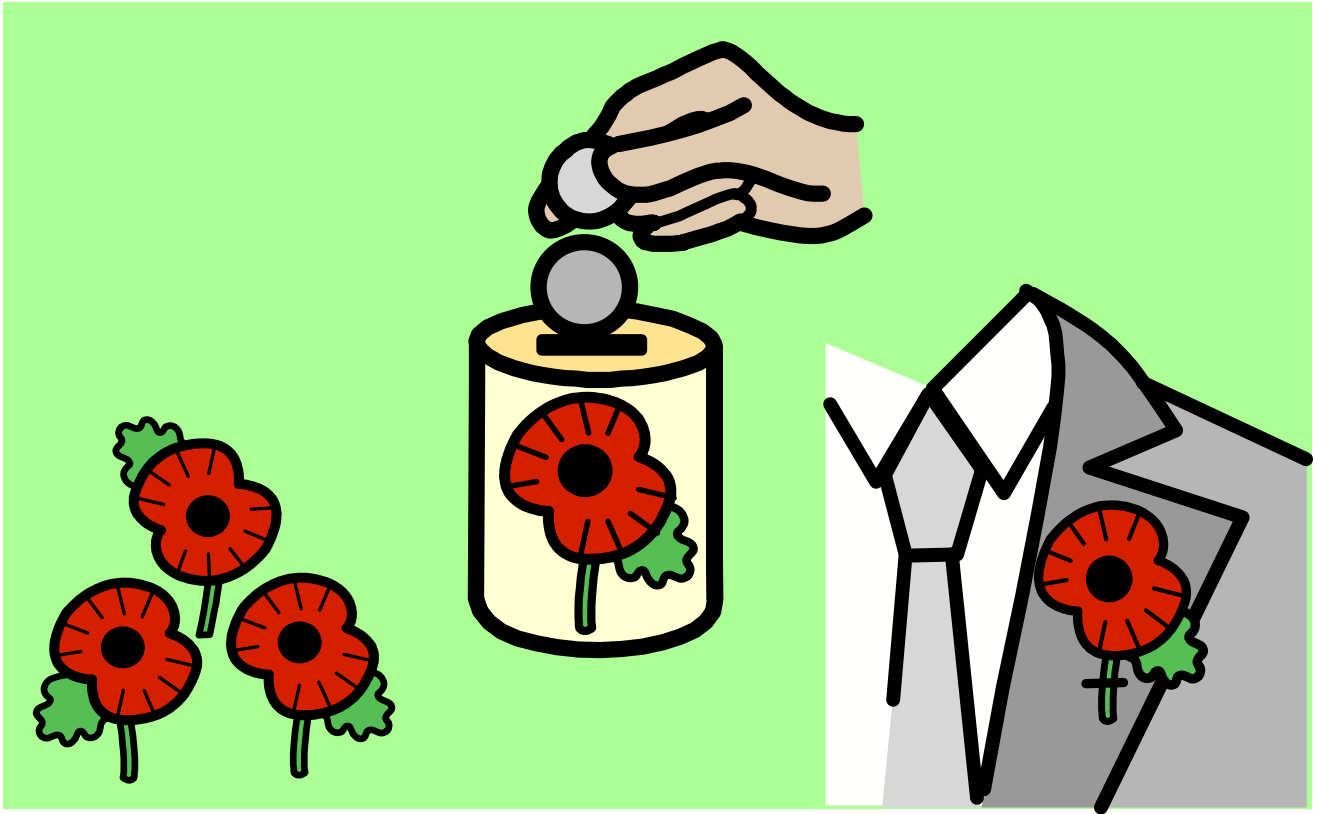

War widows are the wives of soldiers who died.

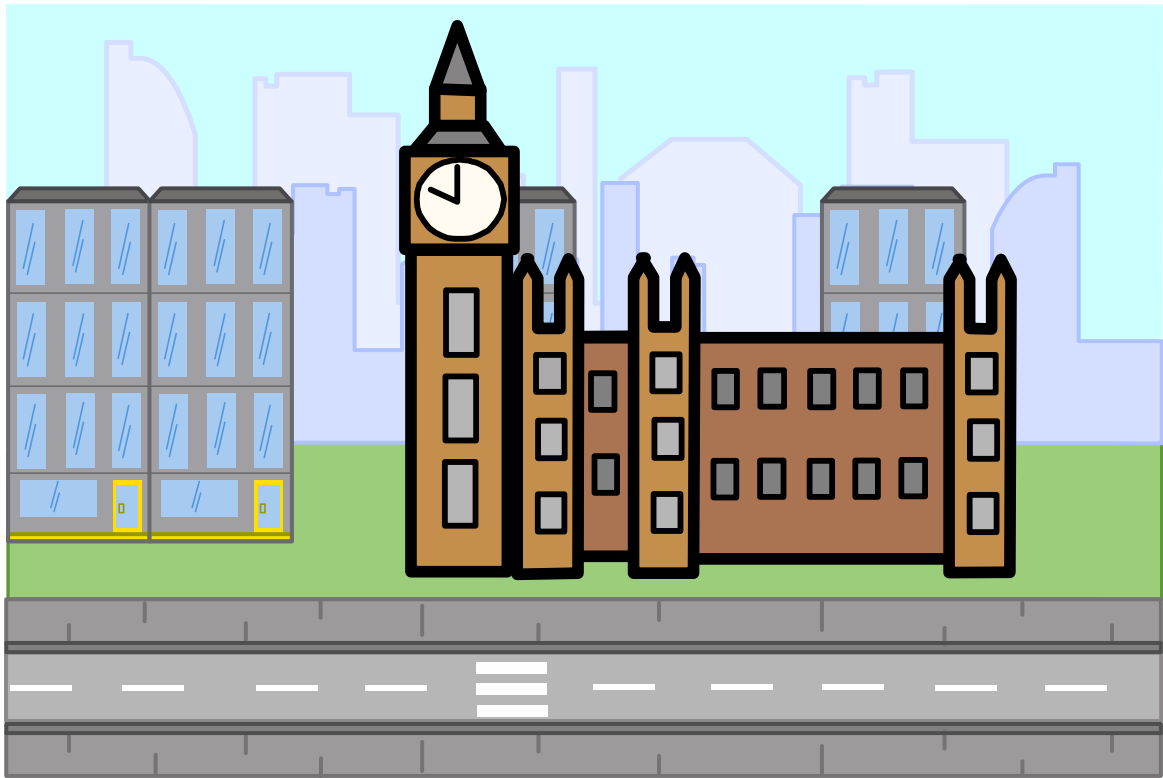


'In Flanders Fields' is a famous poem.

People have worn poppies since 1921.

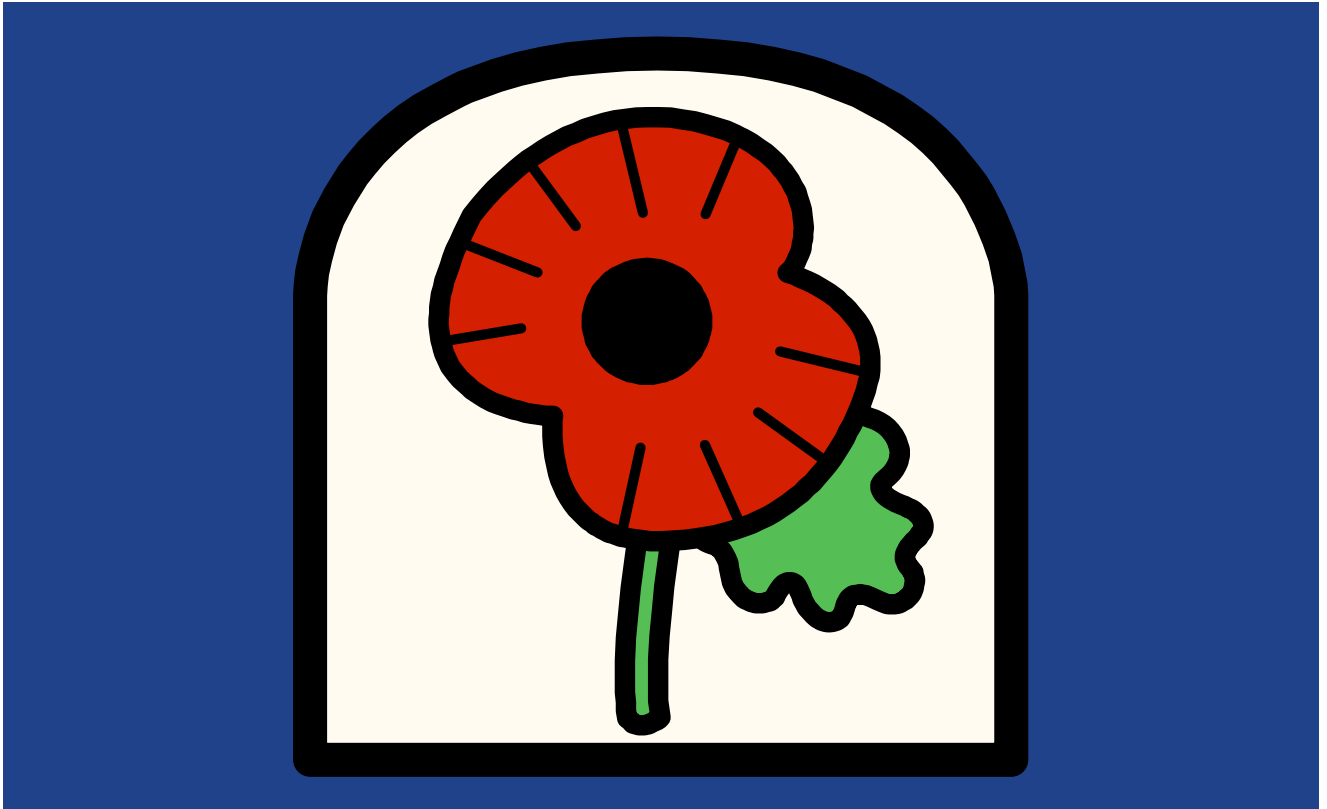


Injured soldiers said they would make poppies.

It makes 38 million poppies every year!

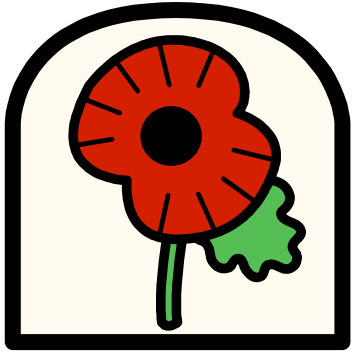


The Royal British Legion organise The Poppy Appeal.

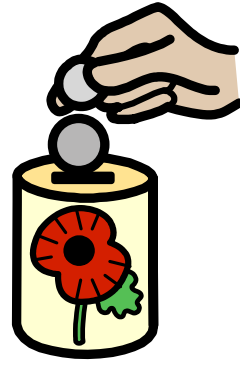
The Legion is a charity and was founded in 1921.

They have lots of volunteers who sell poppies.

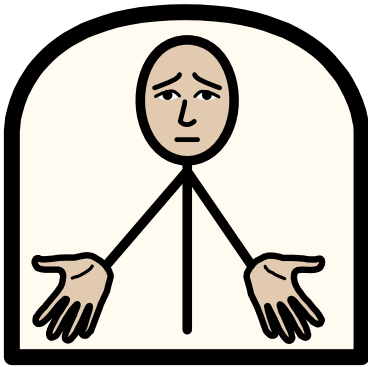
They raise 30 million pounds each year.
