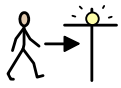

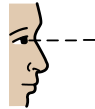
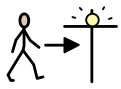


The apostles know Jesus is alive.

He showed himself to Simon and Peter."

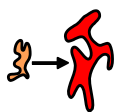


The apostles see Jesus.

The apostles are surprised.

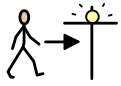


Surprise turns to fear.

Look at my hands and feet. It is really me!"

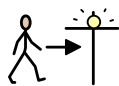


The apostles touch Jesus.

He asks for some food and eats it.

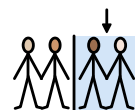
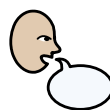
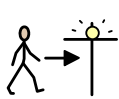
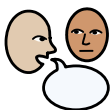


Jesus helps the apostles understand the scriptures.

People must change their hearts and be sorry for their sins.

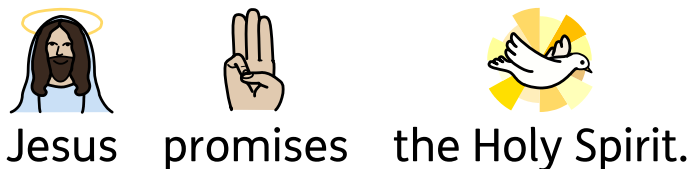
Jesus says, "If they do this then God will forgive them."

I will send it to you.

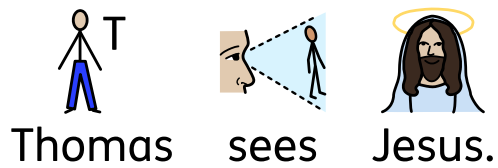
You must stay in Jerusalem until you have received this power."

Thomas says, "I will not believe until I see the nail holes in his hands.

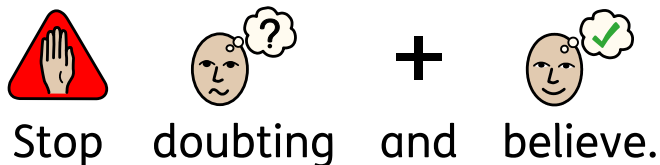
Until I put my finger in those holes and my hand in his side."

Jesus comes and stands with them saying, "Peace be with you."

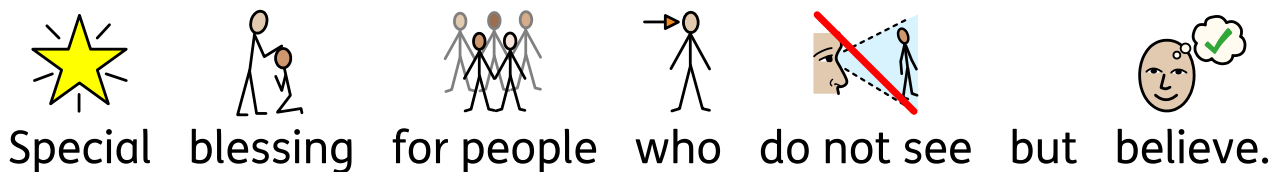
Then Jesus speaks to Thomas.

Put your hand here in my side."







Thomas recognises Jesus and says, "My Lord and my God."

Jesus says, "You believe because you can see me







The people who do not see me and believe will be truly blessed."

They look for fish all night but when morning comes they have none.





Jesus stands on the shore but the men do not recognize him.

The followers catch lots of fish.

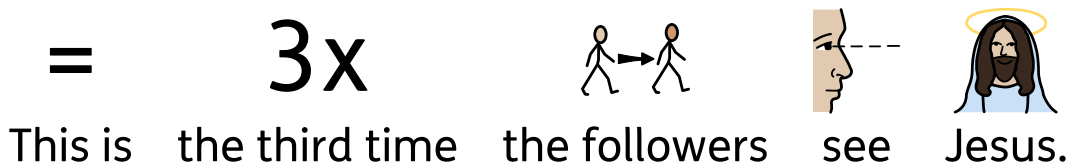
The men do as Jesus tells them.

Now they catch lots of fish.

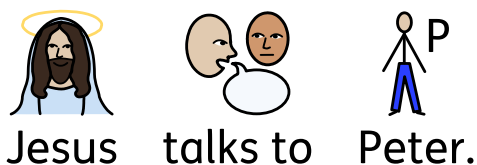
There are so many fish it is hard to pull the net back in the boat.










When the followers get out of the boat they see a fire.
