3. Reading with a partner is fun!





Will you read the text with symbols or the text without symbols?

He sends Jacob to his Uncle Laban's home.







Isaac wants Jacob to find a wife there.

Jacob has a dream.









He dreams there is a ladder.

There are angels going up and down the ladder.










      
Jacob sees God standing by the ladder.

God gives Jacob the land and promises to protect him.






God promises, "I will give you the land you are lying on.
