passage of text.




3. Reading with a partner is fun!







Will you read the text with symbols or the text without symbols?

He tells Abram to leave his country and his people.






God says he will show Abram where to go.

I am going to build a great nation from you.










I am going to use you to bless everyone."

He takes his wife Sarah and his nephew Lot.








He takes his slaves and all the things he owns.
