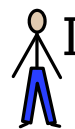

passage of text.

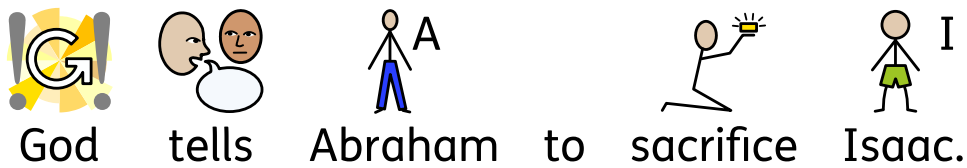

3. Reading with a partner is fun!

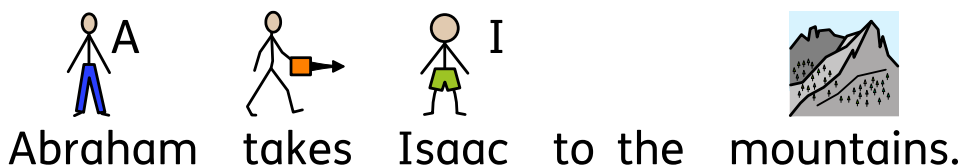
Will you read the text with symbols or the text without symbols?

Abraham gives Isaac the wood to carry.



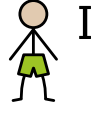
He carries the knife and the fire.

God tells them where to go.


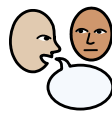
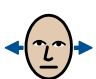

They come to the place for worship.

Now I can see you respect and obey God."

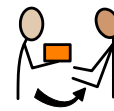
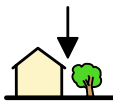


God provides a ram to sacrifice.

Abraham kills the ram.

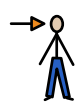


Abraham names the place, 'The Lord provides'.
