Artistic Director








The Artistic Director is in charge of the Company.

The Artistic Director often choreographs new ballets for the Company.







Choreographer









The Choreographer is in charge of choosing dance steps.











The Choreographer works with the Dancers to create movements.
















They attend rehearsals to help Dancers improve the steps.



Designer


















The Designer and Choreographer discuss

The Designer researches and designs the set and costumes.













The designs are given to the Set Builders, Painters and Costume Makers.







Lighting Designer









can create different moods. Lighting












The Lighting Designer talks to the Choreographer and the Designer.











The Lighting Designer plans the lighting and writes a check list.







The Composer **Music Arranger**











The Composer reads the storyline and writes music.







The Composer works closely with the Choreographer.







The music must match the dance steps.











A Music Arranger does not write music.











A Music Arranger rearranges music so it is suitable for the ballet.



The Production Team











A ballet is created and rehearsed for several weeks.









The first performance is called the Opening Night.

on tour to other theatres.





The Production Team help with rehearsals and performances.







Ballet Master (Repetiteur)







The Ballet Master is in charge of rehearsals.













They make sure the Dancers know the dance steps correctly.









The Ballet Master teaches the Dancers every day.













They watch performances and advise the Dancers.



Company Manager









The Company Manager is in charge of looking after the Dancers.













They book

tour

accommodation and transport.













The Company Manager makes sure the Dancers are safe.











book rehearsal studios and write schedules.











They also give the Production Team

tour

information.



Stage Crew











The Stage Crew move scenery during the performance.













The Stage Crew are in charge of transporting scenery the theatres. to







The Chief Mechanist is in charge of the Stage Crew.







A Flyman is in charge of flying scenery.







Stage Manager









The Stage Manager is in charge of cueing the performance.
















They make sure the lights and scenery are operated correctly.















They make sure the Dancers enter and exit at the correct time.











They read the musical score to check timing.



Wardrobe Manager







The Wardrobe Manager is in charge of the costumes.













They measure the Dancers and make alterations to the costumes.

The Dressers help the Dancers change during the ballet.



Wigs Supervisor











Sometimes a Wigs Supervisor goes on tour with a ballet.











make sure the Dancers have the correct hair styles.









Often Dancers will style their own hair.















The Wigs Supervisor helps Dancers with complicated hair styles.









Many hair styles are wigs.











The Wigs Supervisor can organise special makeup.













The Wigs Supervisor would help if a male character needed facial hair.









Most Dancers do makeup themselves.



Technicians









Every performance needs Technicians.









Sound Technicians are in charge of sound and music.











Lighting Technicians are in charge of the Lighting.

The Artistic Team are very important.







They are the Dancers and Musicians.



The Dancers

















The Dancers learn dance steps and rehearse the ballet in a studio.











The Dancers interpret the story and music with movement.

















The Dancers practice familiar ballet exercises everyday.











Practice helps the Dancers to maintain their skills.



Conductor









The Conductor is in charge of leading the Orchestra.













go to ballet rehearsals and sometimes play piano.













Playing piano helps the Conductor understand the music speed.













The music speed must be the correct speed for the dance steps.











During the performance the Conductor stands in front of the Orchestra.













They help the Orchestra keep a regular beat.









The Conductor waves a baton to lead the Orchestra.



The Orchestra









An Orchestra is a large group of Musicians.











an Orchestra plays music during a performance.











They follow sheet music and the Conductor.







Most rehearsals are without the Dancers.













They rehearse with the Dancers once or twice before the first night.





The Engagement Team











During a tour, the Engagement Team meets children.













Dancers and Musicians teach fairy tale workshops.









Children can learn about the production.











Children can develop their dance skills

















During the workshops children can go on to the stage and dance.












