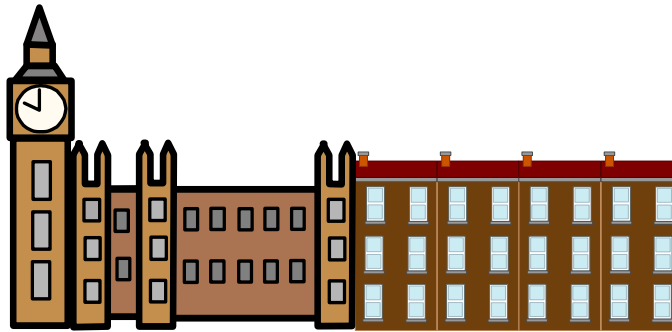


In 1603 James I became King of England.

He met with 5 men; one man was called Guy Fawkes.

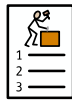
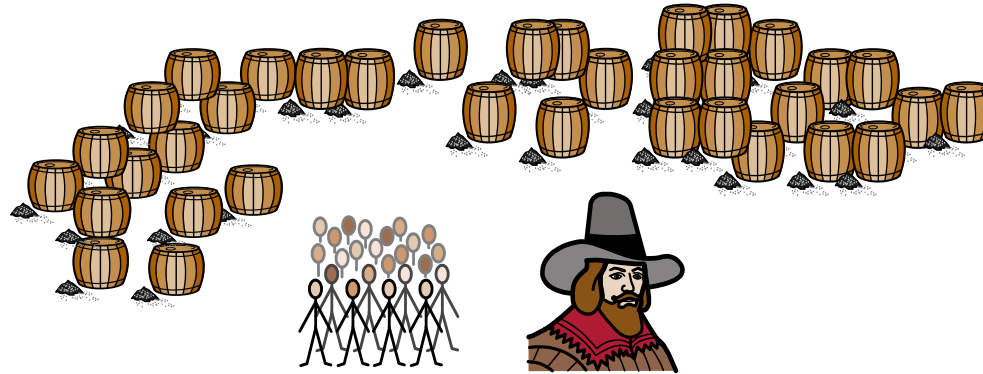


Robert Catesby wanted to get rid of the King and his Parliament.

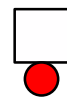
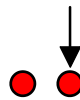
He decided to blow up the Houses of Parliament with gunpowder.

So he and the others rented a building next to the Parliament buildings.

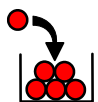
They dug tunnels underneath to get in to the cellars.



Many others joined them in their plot to blow up Parliament.



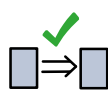
They eventually rented another cellar underneath the House of Lords.



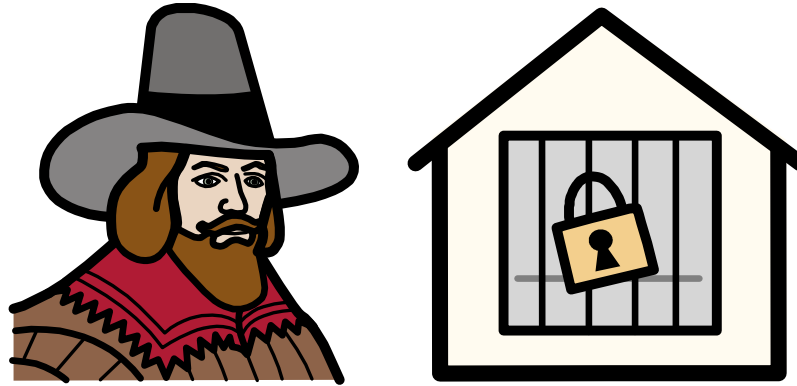


They stored 36 barrels of gunpowder in the cellar.
