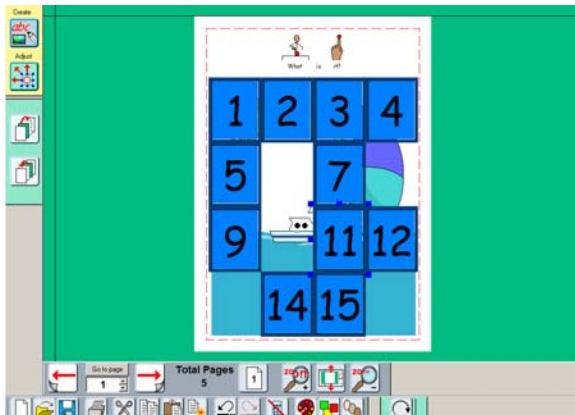


## Communicate: In Print

### Ideas for using an Interactive White Board: Visual Discrimination Activities

#### What is it?

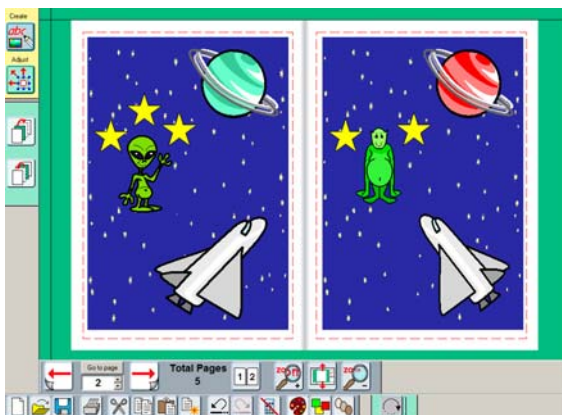


Create a scene  
Switch to Adjust mode and group the scene  
Lock the scene by clicking;  
**Frames and Pictures – Locking – Lock position**

Make a 4 across, 4 down text only table  
Number the cells and format the font  
Place the table to cover the scene  
Switch to Adjust mode - Ungroup the table

‘Play’ in Adjust mode

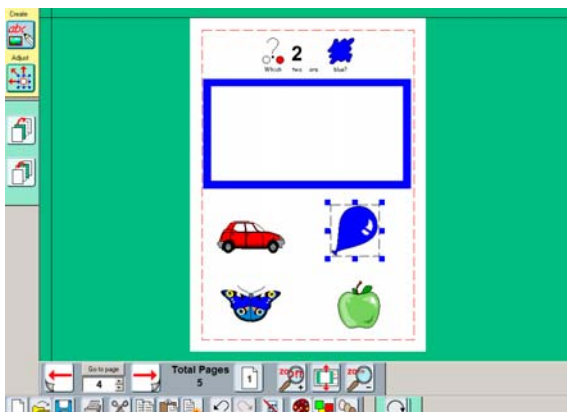
#### Spot the difference



Make a scene  
Switch to Adjust mode and group the scene  
Duplicate the scene  
Move the scene to the 2<sup>nd</sup> page  
Ungroup the 2<sup>nd</sup> scene  
Make changes

Play in one page view  
Show the first page only and allow time to study  
Show the second page only to spot the difference  
Change to two page view to reveal the answers

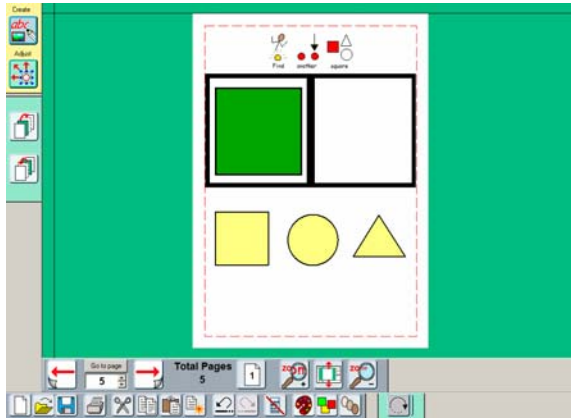
#### Find 2



Make a frame  
Give the frame a border by clicking;  
**Frames and Pictures – Appearance**  
And choose the colour and line thickness  
Lock the frame in position by clicking;  
**Frames and Pictures – Locking - Lock position**  
Use Symbols or Clip Art to add objects  
Change colour of objects as necessary

Click and drag the answers into the frame

## Find another



Make a 2 across, 1 down table  
Add a symbol to the left hand cell  
Lock the position by clicking;

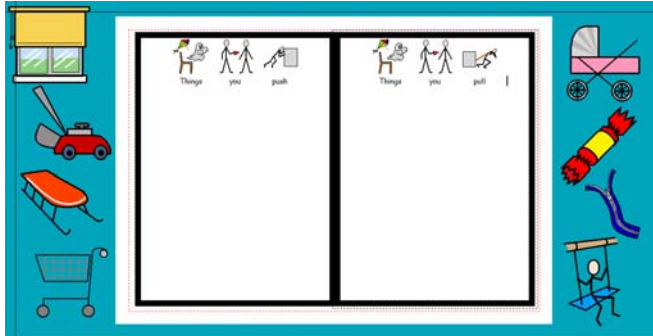
### **Frames and Pictures – Locking - Lock position**

Use Symbols or Clip Art to add objects

Click and drag the answers into the right hand frame

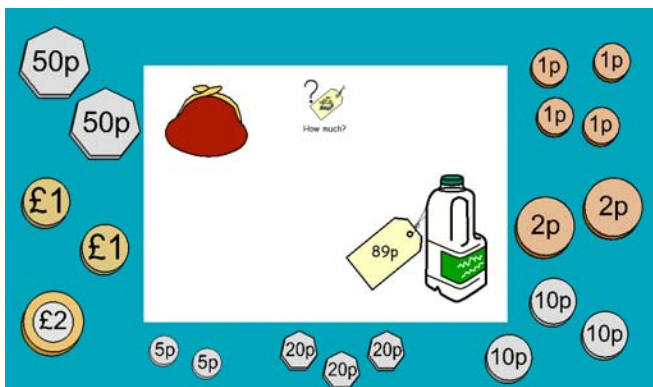
### Sort



Click and drag answers into the correct frames

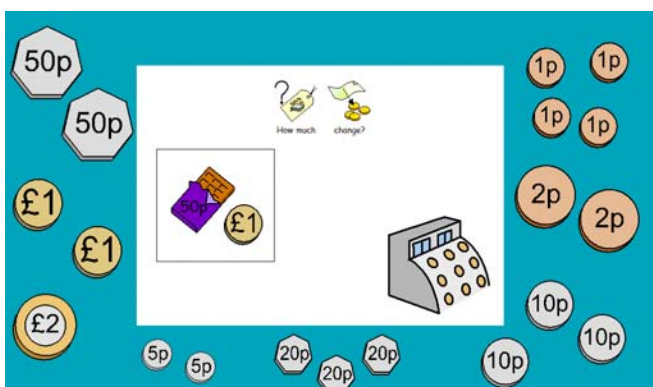
Make a 2 across, 1 down table  
 Add a sentence of instruction to each cell  
 Lock the position by clicking; **Frames and Pictures – Locking - Lock position**  
 Use Symbols or Clip Art to add objects to scratch area  
 Hide Graphics Frame to allow more space  
 Use Zoom In or Zoom Out to adjust space

### Money



Use Symbols or Clipart to add objects to the page  
 Add a sentence of instruction to the top  
 Lock the position by clicking; **Frames and Pictures – Locking - Lock position**  
 Use List to search for coins or notes and place on scratch area

Click and drag coins onto the page to 'pay'



Use Symbols or Clipart to add objects to the page  
 Add a sentence of instruction to the top  
 Lock the position by clicking; **Frames and Pictures – Locking - Lock position**

Use List to search for coins or notes and place on scratch area

Click and drag coins onto the page to 'give change'

## Talking Book



Henry VIII was a **Tudor** king of England.

He liked sports like hunting and jousting.








He had **6** different wives.

Make a book (or open a Widgit Resources History book)

Lock the position by clicking; **Frames and Pictures – Locking - Lock position**

To 'listen' to the book put the cursor at the start of the first sentence and press the speak button

Make a 4 down, 1 across table

Duplicate the table

Adjust the second table so it is narrower and line it up next to the longer table

Duplicate the shorter table

Put the second table in the scratch area

Ungroup the shorter table in the scratch area

Lock the position of the two tables on the page

Type questions in the longer table

Type answers in the table on the scratch area
