



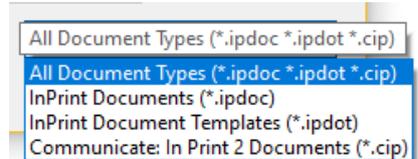
Opening In Print 2 Items

If you previously used In Print 2, you may wish to open and use old documents, resources or images. This is simple to do within InPrint 3

Legacy Documents

InPrint 3 will open any of your old In Print 2 documents (**.cip files**) and give you the option to save them in the latest file format (**.ipdoc**).

To open an existing document, select the **Open** option in the **File Tab**. From here you can choose to open **.ipdoc** files or **.cip** files. Double clicking on a **.cip** file will import your old resource into InPrint 3 and allow you to edit it as you would any other file.

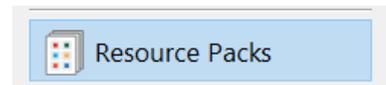


You can also open **.ipdoc** files or **.cip** files by dragging them into the application from Windows Explorer.

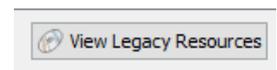
Selecting **Save As** from the **File Tab** will give you the option to save the document as an **.ipdoc file**.

Legacy Resources

InPrint 3 will open any of your In Print 2 resource packs. On the **File Tab**, click the **Resource Packs** button.



To view the In Print 2 resource packs installed on your machine, click the **View Legacy Resources** button at the bottom of the screen.



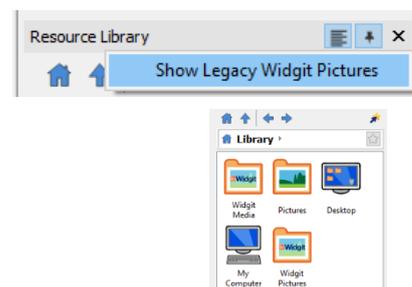
Double-clicking on a **.cip** file will import your old resource into InPrint 3 and allow you to edit it as you would any other file.

Clicking **Save As** on the **File tab** will give you the option to save the document as an **.ipdoc file**. Please note, you cannot open .ipdoc files in In Print 2.

Legacy Images

With the release on InPrint 3, our design team re-drew our **Widgit Media** items. However, you may still wish to access the old **Widgit Pictures**.

In the **Resource Library**, there is a small **Menu** button. Click on this and select **Show Legacy Widgit Pictures**.



Another folder – **Widgit Pictures**– is now visible in the **Library**.
