



How to Recolour Symbols

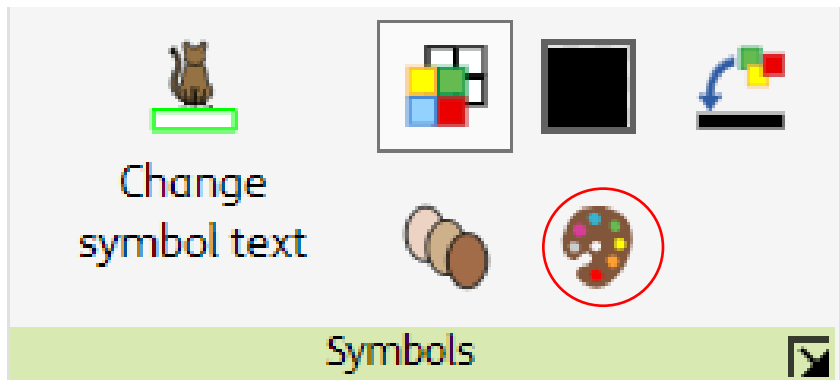
It is possible to re-colour the Widgit Symbols in both the Template Editor and the Document Editor. This can be useful, for example to make the car symbol match the colour of an actual car, or to change clothing colours.

Changing Symbol Colours in the Documents Editor.

1. Type your text as required. Select, or place the cursor within, the text for the symbol you wish to change.



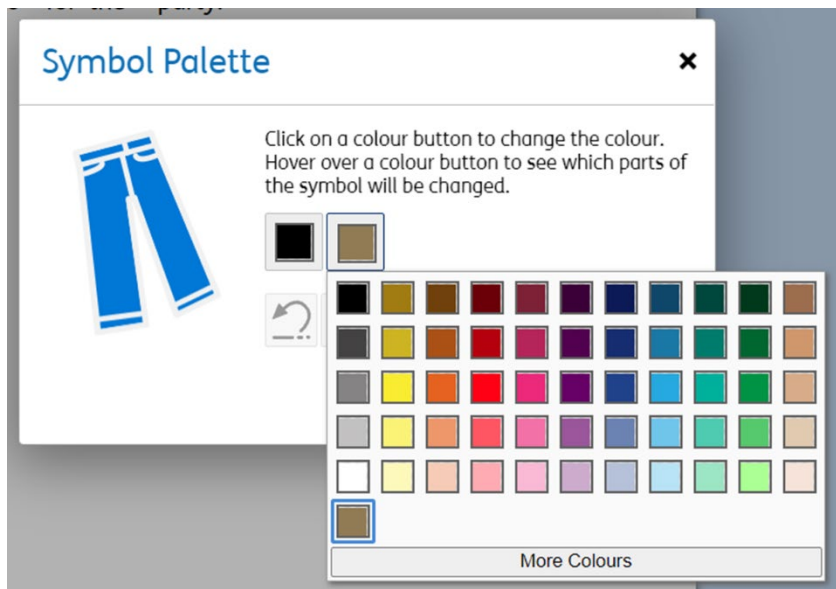
2. On the **Formatting** tab, in the **Symbols** section, click on the artist's palette.



3. You will see a pop-up with the selected symbol and the colours used.



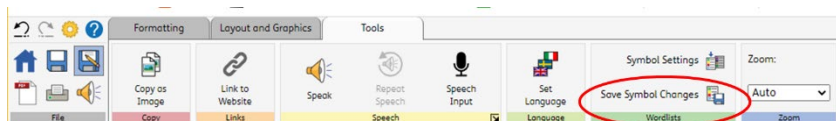
4. Click on a colour to change it. The colour you are changing will be highlighted blue. Click the new / replacement colour desired, and **OK** when you have finished.



5. The symbol will now have changed.



6. You can save the changes if you wish, so they will be available next time. Click on the **Tools** tab, and in the **Wordlists** section, select **Save Symbol Changes**.



- The pop-up will appear; with the word you have changed on the left. You can select an existing **Wordlist** on the right - hand side or create a **New Wordlist** in the centre. Click the **Add** or the **Add All** button once you have selected the **Wordlist**. Finally, Click **OK**.

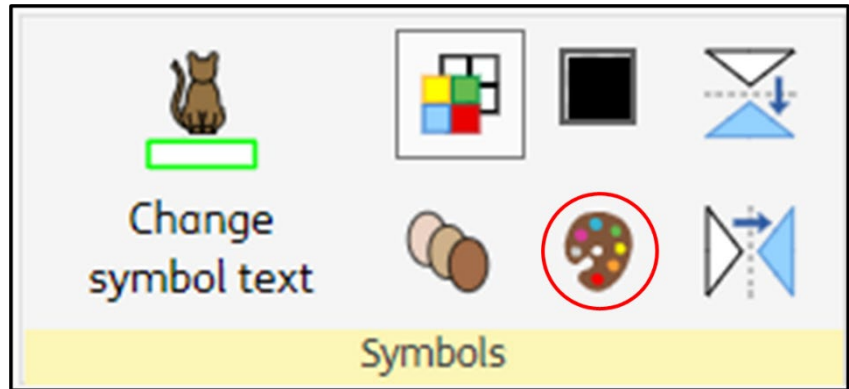

Changing Symbol Colours in the Template Editor.

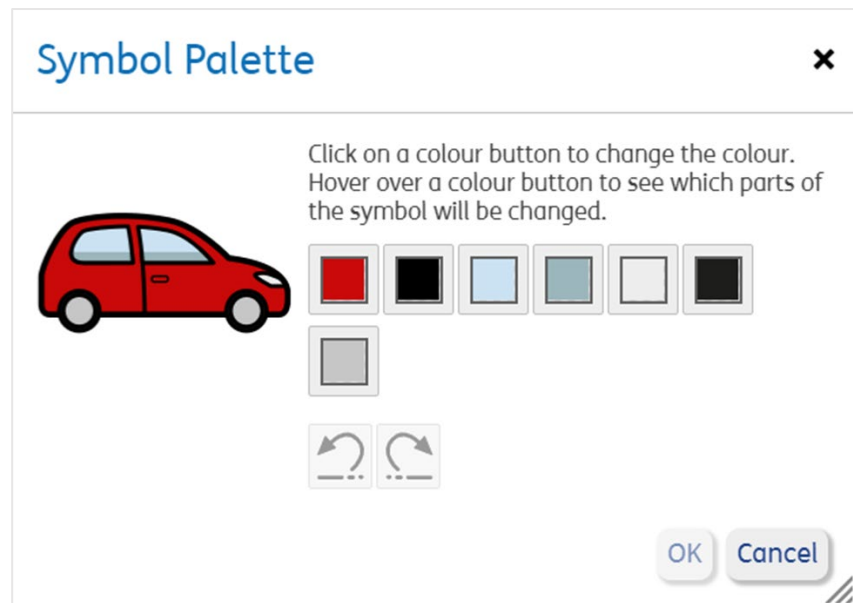
- Type your text as required. Select the symbol you wish to change.



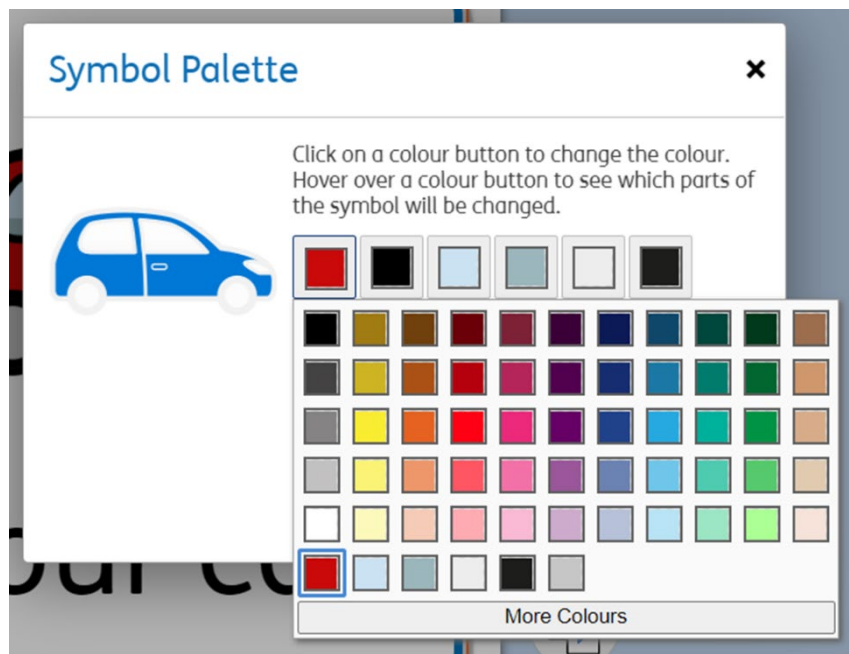
2. On the **Formatting** tab, in the **Symbols** section, click on the artist's palette.



3. You will see a pop-up with the selected symbol and the colours used.



4. Click on a colour to change it. The colour you are changing will be highlighted blue. Click the new / replacement colour desired, and **OK** when you have finished.



5. The symbol will now have changed.



6. To save, use the same process as in the **Documents Editor** (points 6 & 7)
