If a character hides you can help find them by shouting "behind you".











Sometimes, the characters will walk around the audience.











There will be music, flashing lights and special effects.











The pantomime can be very noisy.







At the end of part one the curtains will close.









The lights will come up for the interval.







Lots of people will leave their seats.













You can buy a drink or ice cream and go to the toilet.







An usher will announce when part two is starting.





You should return to your seat.









You might have to show your ticket again.









The lights will go dark again.





Part two will begin.











Sit and watch the performance again.







There will be songs to sing.







You can sing if you want to.









At the end of the show everyone is happy
