

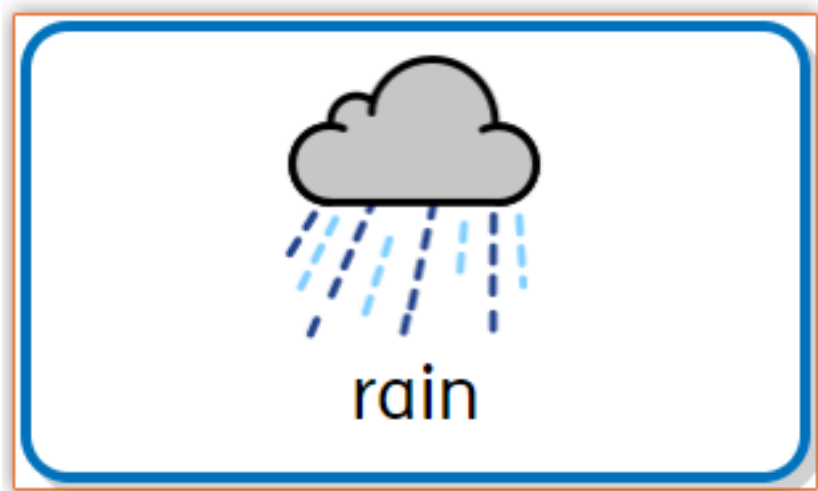


How to Use Two Symbols in a Template

Sometimes you may wish to add a second symbol into a frame. For example combining “rain” and “play” to show it is wet play. You can use all symbols, or use a combination of a symbol and an image from the image library or Pixabay images.

Using Two Symbols.

1. Click in a cell and **type** the first symbol “rain”.

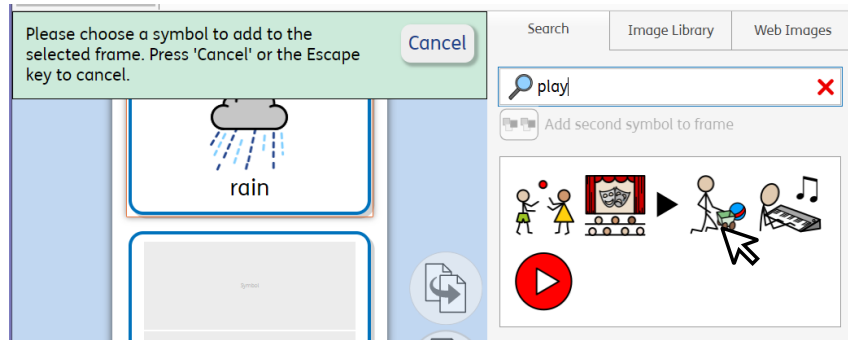


2. Then in the **Symbol Chooser** click on the **Add second symbol to frame** button.

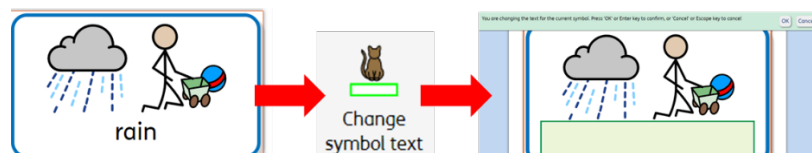


Add second symbol to frame

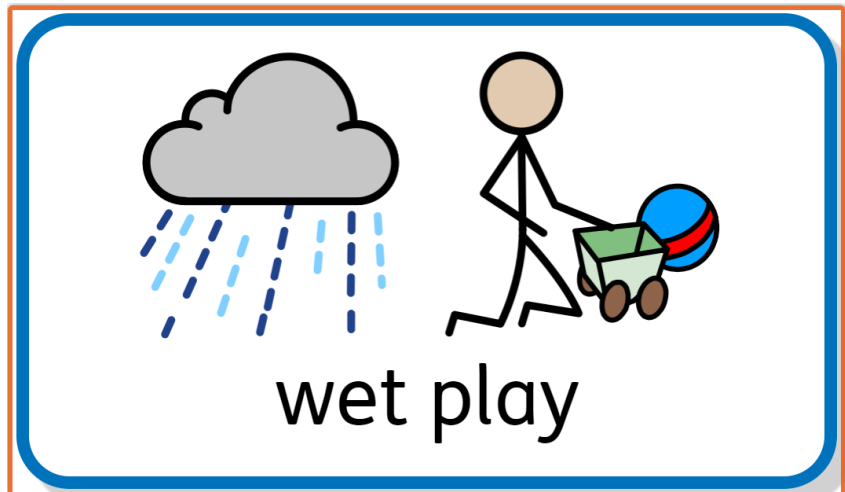
3. Then **search** for the second symbol "play". When you click on the symbol it will be added to the frame.



4. You can then use the **Change symbol text** button to change the text.

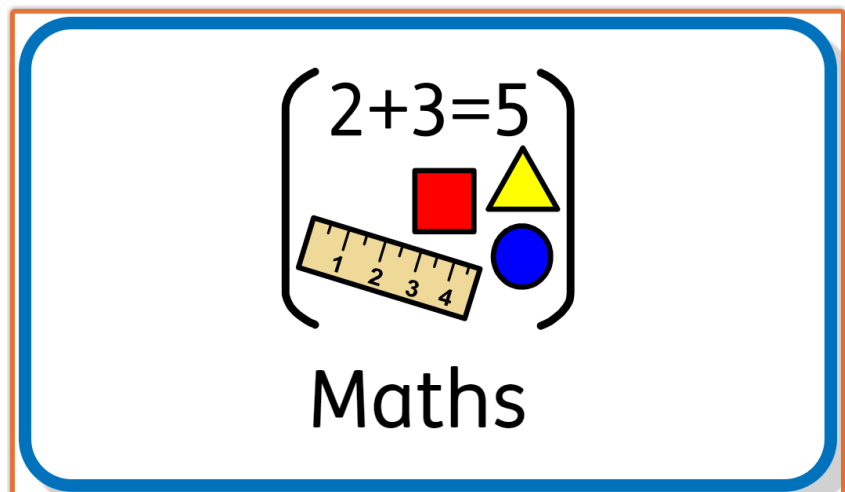


5. You now have one cell, two symbols.



Using an Image.

6. Click in a cell and **type** the first symbol “maths”.

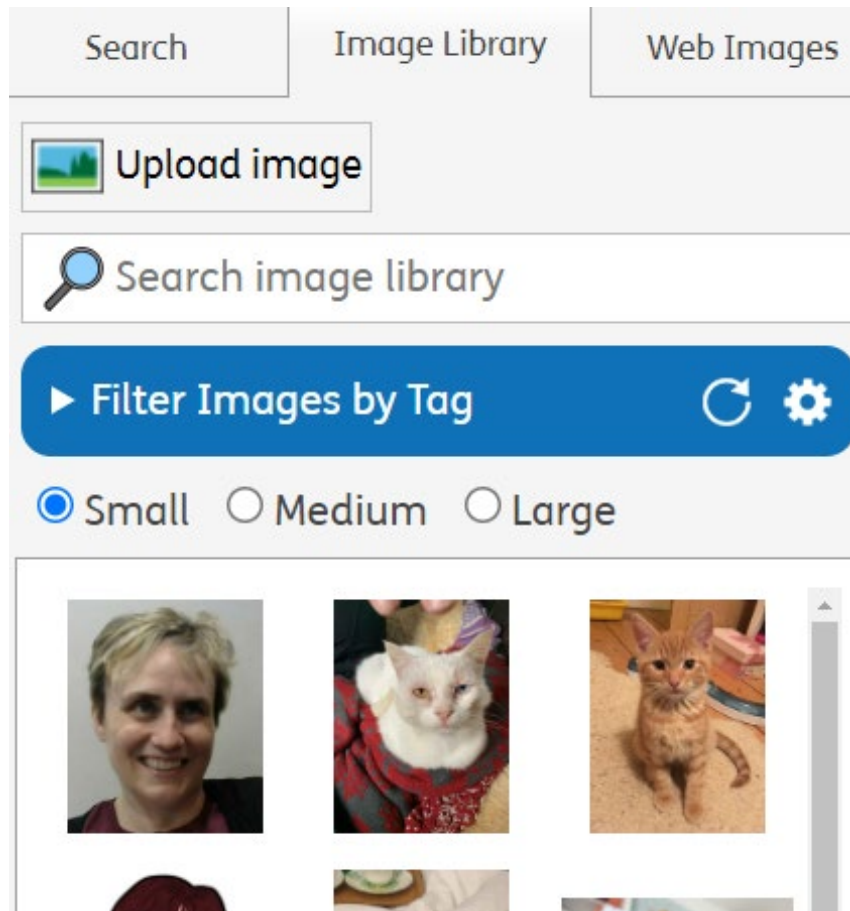


7. Then in the **Symbol Chooser** click on the **Add second symbol to frame** button.

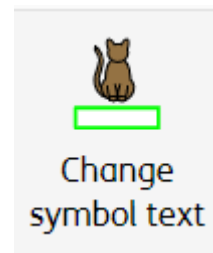


Add second symbol to frame

8. Then select **the Image Library Tab** and select your chosen image.



9. You can then use the **Change symbol text** button to change the text.



10. You now have one cell, two images.
